Specifically, Aspen Spring Flooring Laminate has products that are documented to have met emissions requirements for CARB 93120 – 93120.12 Title 17 and are CARB-ATCM Certified by a CARB approved third party certifier.

Specifically, Aspen Spring Flooring Solid Hardwood does not apply to the CARB emissions standard because it is a solid flooring product and not engineered using adhesives that could potentially contain dangerous levels of formaldehyde.
